In English this week the children have begun to publish their non-fiction writing. This is a new skill for many of the children and so it has proved to be quite tricky learning. In maths we have revisited identifying one more and one less but with larger numbers. We have been deciding whether the statement needed to complete the number sentence is more than, less than or equal to.
