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Our Learning Journey

This week in English we have been practising using the conjunctions and, or, so and but. It is important the children use a variety of conjunctions when joining their sentences.

In Maths we have been learning about 2D shapes. We learnt about the properties of 2D shapes using the maths vocabulary sides and vertices. We investigated how many lines of symmetry 2D shapes have and also sorted shapes in a variety of different ways using Venn diagrams.

In DT we designed our moving picture and then made it. We had to include at least one moving mechanism. We chose a scene from either The Gingerbread Man or Little Red Riding Hood. I thought their final products looked fantastic!

In RE we are learning why Jesus told parables. This week we have been learning about the parable of The Lost Sheep.
