In English this week we planned our own fire myth based on the story 'The Rainbow Bird' by Eric Maddern. We also practised using conjunctions when, if, that.

In Maths we have been learning about length. We have enjoyed using rulers and metre sticks to measure different items around the classroom. We used the vocabulary longer than, shorter than, longest and shortest.

We have been learning about how to stay safe in a fire. We made posters with the seven fire safety rules. Ask your child what the rules are. We also had a visit from Surrey Fire Brigade. The children loved exploring the fire engine and the best bit was spraying the hose.
