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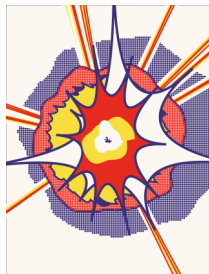
Our Learning Journey

This week we have started thinking about our enquiry question 'What makes superhero special?'

In English the children designed their own superhero. They focused on the initial sound of their first name e.g. Helpful Harry. They then began thinking of other words with the same initial sound to give more information about their superhero.

In our enquiry based learning this week we labelled basic parts of the human body. We also began to look at the artist Roy Lichtenstein. He used a technique called Ben Day Dots and the children replicated this.

This week in maths we have been looking at the different equipment we can use to represent numbers. This week we focused on multilink cubes and numicon.

We have been revisiting previous learnt sounds and consolidating our knowledge.

This week we have been looking at the phonemes ai, ee, igh and oa. We have played a new game called Quickwrite which the children enjoyed.
