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Our Learning Journey

This week in English we found a rucksack containing some clues! The children predicted where they thought these might have come from. The clues linked to the new text we are focusing on; Charlie's Superhero Underpants. The children were very imaginative with their ideas!

In Maths this week we have been focusing on one more and one less, developing our understanding and consolidating our skills ready for more tricky learning. We also investigated what a 'Mastery Challenge' looks like in Woodpecker Class. This when we focus on problem solving and reasoning and try and stretch our learning stars.

In our enquiry learning this week we have carried on looking at Roy Lichtenstein's art work. We talked about onomatopoeia and called these our 'battle words'.
