Our Learning Journey


In English this week the children have had the opportunity to re-tell the story of Charlie's Superhero Underpants using props. We had a learning conversation about how we re-tell a story and that it is important we include the key events. The children have also drawn a story map in preparation for writing a re-count next week.

In Maths we looked at the part whole model; splitting numbers into different parts. This led into our learning around addition towards the end of the week. I have been very impressed with how the children's resilience has developed when learning independently during our maths sessions.

In our Enquiry learning next week we will be continuing to develop our piece of art work inspired by Roy Lichtenstein. The children will be taking great care painting these to share with you at our celebration of learning. The date of this will be confirmed next week.
